Teams of Ten 2016

This years event is being hosted by Target Shooting Hutt Valley at the Keane Range, Petone on Saturday 14^{th} May. We have entered 1 team which will compete in the Rees Scroll Division. The team consists of 10 shooters plus 1 reserve. All shoot 2x20 shot matches and shoot in reverse seeded order i.e. #10 seed shoots detail 1, #9 seed shoots detail 2 etc until everyone has completed 1x20 then the process starts again for the 2^{nd} 20 shot. This is a very unique team shoot and in the past has created a pressure that shooters may have never encounted before. It is a long day but it is something worth doing. The team will be selected by the TSA Selectors and finalised by the end of April.
