Teams of Ten 2024 update

The Auckland Selectors are still keen on having 2 Auckland teams for this event. If you have not already contacted either myself of one of the selectors (Steve P, Jono G, Ian M) then get to it.

To smoothly run this event we are going to need people. I am now calling for volunteers for the following roles.....

- Chief Marker must know the TSNZ Rules and will be in the marking room for ALL details being marked. (Able to exit only between details). Markers will be from other associations.
- Chief Range Officer x2 must have done the TSNZ Rage Officers course and have a solid knowledge of the TSNZ Rules. As there will be 2, there will be time to shoot if required.
- Range Officers x4 must have done the TSNZ Range Officers course. There will be 1 R/O upstairs and 1 downstairs in addition to the Chief R/O. The 2 not required for each detail can shoot if needed.
- Score computer person computer knowledge an asset. We are planning to have the scores on internet live.



- Catering helpers to assist Megan P and her mum at the Tennis Club. Able to shoot if needed.
- Score recorder onto the sheets for all shooters to see must have tidy hand writing. Score sheets will be prepared earlier in the week so only scores required on the day.
- Target changers x8 the plan is to have 4 changing targets at a time so to ensure a fast turn. All 8 can swap around as required and shoot if needed, but 4 must be available at any time.
- Runners x2 able to get info, score sheets, squad sheets and find people quickly. Able to shoot is required.
- Coordinator for the dinner event x1 tickets, info etc for all teams

We need your help to make this event run smoothly. Let me know what you able to help out with ASAP.

For your info – The Friday evening will be a practice evening, Team managers meeting and North Island AGM. The meetings will be held in the clubroom of the HRC. Exactly where in the lounge is yet to be decided. On Saturday morning there will be another official practice time window. More info on these coming in the next few weeks.
