TEAMS OF TEN 2022

As mentioned previously, this shoot was to be held in May this year however COVID got in the way. It will now be on Saturday 27th August hosted by Taranaki Association in Wanganui.

This event is thought of as the pinnacle event for the North Island. It involves 10 shooters from each province, all shooting 20 shot cards, no practicing, pre-squadded, shooting in reverse seeded order (e.g. seeds 10 in first, then seeds 9 etc until everyone has shot once, then it starts again, seeds 10 first, then seeds 9 etc until the end) with shooters shooting approx 5 hours between details. Sound like fun? NO. It is for some reason an event that creates its own pressure on shooters and not surprisingly, there are more "what the" moments than any other shoot in the year. Good luck to the Auckland team.

AUCKLAND PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 (aka the BIG 7)

4 events completed, 3 to go. The next round will be on Saturday 6th August @ Te Awamutu. This event is the South Waikato Open (previously hosted at Putararu).

It is recommended that you attend this event if you are able to. I have a full list of where individuals are placed in this Big 7 competition so drop me a line if you are interested. To qualify for the competition (and there are trophies for the winners in each grade) you need to shoot at 5 of the 7 events, minimum. Simply put, your best 5 scores (3x10 grade scores) count.

Note that Round 6 of the competition is the Waitakere Open on 3rd September. A poster is coming your way shortly. Support your local Auckland area club.
