HOW TO GET THERE:

For those who do not know how to get to the Hamilton range here is an explanation: SH1 turn off to Gordonton (Gordonton Road). This road connects to Wairere Drive which will take you directly to the range. Stay on Wairere Drive and approx 200 meters prior to the end of the road (T junction) the range will be on the left side. There is a sealed car park in front of the building.

If you are at all unsure where you are going, ASK me please. Those who need club equipment make sure transportation of this is sorted.
