TSA Open 2013

The TSA Auckland Open, Round 4 of the Auckland Provincial Championship, is happening on Saturday 22nd June. As with previous years the event is run by all members of TSA.

A poster for the event was e-mailed to you on 5th June. The format for the day will be the same as previous years. Howick members will operate the range from 9:00am until 12:30pm and the combined force of the west clubs members will then take over through to the finish. The kitchen will be run by Howick.

You may be in a shooting slump or at the other end of the scale, either way we all know the nature of this fantastic sport so come and have a go, you have to be in to win. TSA needs your support.

An example of how things can change for the better on a single card is Malachy who is a B Grader going through a rough patch and then the next card he shot produced a **100.10** a couple of weeks ago. Congratulations Malachy.

Auckland Teams coming up

The next team requirements are for the following:

- Titipounamu (8 persons, A Graders and below eligible)
- Inter Association Postal (5 persons per grade, All grades along with Ladies and Junior divisions)
- Hutt Valley Teams of 5 postal (5 persons, B Graders and below eligible)
- Commonwealth Cities postal (15 persons, all graders eligible)
- Auckland BSA team (12 persons, selected from Auckland and Waikato shooters)
- Auckland v's Waikato (10 persons Open Grade, 5 persons A Grade, 5 persons B Grade, 5 Ladies, 5 Juniors. NB: Ladies and Junior can also shoot in one of the graded teams however those in graded team can not shoot in another graded team at this event.)

All the above shoots will be held at Howick.

Auckland Provincial Championship 2013

This competition is a combination of the "Big 7" Open Championships held throughout the season @ Te Puke, Hamilton, Howick, TSA, Putaruru, Waitakere and Thames (hosted by Hamilton). To be eligible for a title at the end of this competition, a shooter must have completed 5 of the 7 shoots. The TSA secretary is the competition coordinator so if you are interested in knowing how you are placed in the competition please ask Rob.

The first 2 competitions had less shooters' than previous years however Howick was well attended and there were some excellent scores shot. The TSA Open is on 22nd June so here is another competition in your "own back yard" so let's keep both the attendance and scores high.
